Dance Force will be operated and directed by Jennifer Hodge.

The Dance Force program is committed to train dance technique, performance quality and teamwork, which promotes creativity, self-confidence and a sense of accomplishment.

- CYS member price will be set at \$35.00 a month. Tuition will not be pro-rated for the shorter months or months with holidays. The first and last months tuition is due at the time of registration. All students must be enrolled by February 1st in order to participate in the end of year show.
- Classes will start the week of August 15th and run thru mid May. Dance classes will not meet on regular on post school holidays and all federal holidays. Tuition will not be pro-rated for holidays, nor will there be makeup classes.
- Class space for pre-dance/creative movement will be 18 dancers, pre-jazz, jazz , and hip hop 20 dancers, Beg and Int. Ballet/Tap combo classes 20
- All dance classes will begin promptly at scheduled times. Students must be on time and MUST be picked up when class ends. Dance Force is not a baby sitting service and will not be responsible for children not in scheduled classes. In addition for your child's safety, all other children not in scheduled classes must be seated and supervised in the waiting area. NO RUNNING around in the fine arts center.
- No parents, observers, or visitors are allowed in the dance room unless prior arrangements have been made with the instructor. Class observation days will be scheduled for the parents to visit
- Class rules must be followed in order to remain enrolled in dance class. Rules are as follows: students must be in proper dance attire, no food or drinks in the dance room, be on time, attend regularly, be respectful and courteous to instructors and fellow students, participate fully, no parents or observers in the dance room, and dancers must use the restroom prior to class.
- Dance Force will hold an end of the year dance recital in May. There will be a full dress rehearsal before the show that all dancers are required to attend. Classes will also perform at Fort Benning festivals, and other community events throughout the year.
- There will be additional costume orders for the end of year dance recital. Cost for the recital costume will be \$45.00. All costume orders and payments will be handled thru Jennifer Hodge, director of Dance Force.

Proper dance attire and correct dance shoes are required in order to participate in class. Dancewear and shoes can be purchased from either Dance Force directly, or area/online stores. It is important to purchase the right style and color of class attire since some of the items will be used for performances and the end of the year show.

Dance Attire:

Pre-Dance/Creative Movement: (\$45.00) cap sleeve pink leotard, pink tights, black tap shoes, and pink ballet shoes. Optional ballet skirt (\$10.00) Hair must be pulled back from face.

Jazz Combo classes: (\$43.00) Black cap sleeve style leotard or Dance Force logo leotard, long black jazz pants (no biker shorts) and black jazz shoes. Hair must be pulled back from face.

Beg. & Int. Ballet and Tap class: (\$56.00) cap sleeve black leotard, black tights, black tap shoes, black ballet shoes, and black ballet skirt. Hair must be pulled back from face.

Hip Hop classes: Dance Force t-shirt (\$10.00), black comfortable pants, (no jeans or shorts) and tennis shoes. Hair must be pulled back from face.
